# 7. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

#### 8. NEW BUSINESS

**8-1.** Ohlone Greenway Plan for Submittal to BART, including Planting Plan and Path Alignment.

Parks and Recreation Commission recommendation: Adopt Gates and Associates plan, as modified and improved upon in the Tree Task Force plan, with the following modifications: 1) Revisit placement of trees and shrubs at intersection corners to ensure visibility of bicyclists and pedestrians. 2) City should ask BART for a placeholder value of the par course. 3) All park benches (including Lions and Rotary Club benches) and "wooden cube" benches should be replaced if removed or damaged. 4) Encourage City Council to be conscious of adequate budget for maintenance. 5) Adhere to installing a two foot decomposed granite (DG) path on either side of the bicycle/pedestrian path. (Note: El Cerrito has chosen to install only one DG path for cost saving measures).

**8-2.** Ballot arguments on City Charter Amendments and Tax Measures.

Staff recommendation: Designate a Council subcommittee to write arguments on the proposed measures to be submitted to the voters at the November 4, 2008 election.
