A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING STAFF TO SUBMIT THE 2016-2017 CITY OF ALBANY PARATRANSIT PROGRAM PLAN APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,668.00 TO THE ALAMEDA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, in November 2000 the voters of Alameda County approved the half-cent transportation sales tax through the passage of Measure B, re-approving the tax measure originally passed in 1986 and;


WHEREAS, in November 2014, voters approved Measure BB which renews the half-cent transportation sales tax approved in 2000 and increases the tax by another half-cent and;

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Transportation Commission has responsibility in reviewing plans and administering an estimated amount of \$4,346,519.00 of Measure B funds and \$3,926,102.00 of Measure BB this fiscal year for cities that provide “Special Transportation for Seniors and People with Disabilities” and;

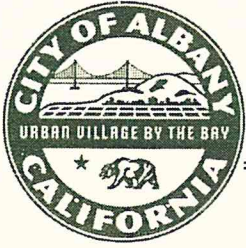
WHEREAS, the City of Albany will be receiving an estimated amount of \$65,668.00 for fiscal year 2016-2017 and;
