All plastic containers numbers 1-7 and wide-mouth plastic containers numbers 2, 4, 5 can now be placed in your gray recycling cart with other mixed recycling.

These plastic containers include:  
Clamshell food containers, margarine tubs, yogurt cups, fruit and pudding snack cups, deli containers, plastic peanut butter and mayonaise jars.

Remove food from containers before placing them into your cart. Containers with food cannot be recycled.




Gray recycling cart is collected weekly. Lid must close.

Plastic bags and wrapping must be bundled into one plastic bag and self-tied. Do not use twist ties, rubber bands or tape.
