A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH RANEY UNLIMITED FOR PUBLIC WORKS SERVICE CENTER FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT PLANNING AND INSTALLATION

WHEREAS, at the January 19, 2016 City Council meeting, the City Council approved various agreements associated with implementation of the design, financing, and construction of a new Public Works Service Center at 540 Cleveland Avenue; and

WHEREAS, as part of the agreements, \$400,000 has been set aside for the purchase and installation of furniture, fixtures and equipment required for the facility to be operational; and

WHEREAS, in order to relocate into the new Public Works Department facility in a timely manner next summer, it is important that the space planning and furniture and equipment purchasing decisions be initiated; and

WHEREAS, Raney Unlimited provides specialized knowledge that City staff does not have. In addition, retention of Raney Unlimited will allow City staff to focus on overall project management responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Raney Unlimited for an amount of \$46,000 for a period of two years.
