WHEREAS, The Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District (KPPCSD) is currently attempting to identify a suitable provider for public safety dispatch and records management services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department Public Safety Answering Point (9-1-1 Communications Center) is a potential provider of these services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the KPPCSD has adopted a resolution authorizing KPPCSD personnel to enter into negotiations with the City of Albany as a potential public safety dispatch and records management service provider; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager wishes to fully explore the feasibility, including economic and operational implications, of providing said services to the KPPCSD; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager will seek authorization from City Council prior to entering into a Dispatch and Records Services Agreement with the KPPCSD;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or her designee to enter into negotiations with the Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District for the provision of public safety dispatch and records management services.
