Claire Griffing provided an update – The first EBCE board meeting was held on January 30th, where they discussed the community advisory committee, timelines, service contracts, and the possibility of having Contra Costa County cities join.

5-3. Update on green building reach codes

The Planning and Zoning Commission has established a Green Building Subcommittee and plans to meet soon.

CivicSpark Climate Fellow Fanny Yang gave a presentation summarizing on Berkeley BESO data and the Committee discussed the findings.

Committee Member Cooper provided an update – the festival planning team recommends forming an ad hoc subcommittee with representatives from the Arts Committee, Sustainability Committee, and the public.

6-5. Report from Climate Action Plan Implementation Subcommittee

Sustainability Committee provided input on the Climate Action Plan Implementation Subcommittee draft proposal for a pilot effort on a building survey and building energy audit program. Components considered included: the number of buildings for the audit, what information will be collected through the survey, and ensuring good representation of city residents and city building stock.

Griffing shared an opportunity with the School District – Stopwaste is offering free ZNE technical assistance.
