
1	ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 03
2	AN ORDINANCE OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL
3	AMENDING CHAPTER 8 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE,
4	BICYCLE REGULATIONS
5	
6	WHEREAS, Section 8-12 of the Albany Municipal Code regulates bicycles
7	in the City of Albany; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, Section 8-12.4.b prohibits adults and children over the age of 16
0	from riding bicycles on sidewalks; and
1	
2	WHEREAS, the City of Albany has approved a mixed-use development
3	project located at the corner of San Pablo Avenue and Monroe Street; and
4	
15	WHEREAS, the UC Village mixed use project includes a two-way bicycle
6	path adjacent to the sidewalk on the west side of San Pablo Avenue; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, on the north side of the UC Village project, the two-way bicycle
19	path terminates mid-block; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, it is not safe for bicyclists on the bicycle-path to transition to San
22	Pablo Avenue roadway mid-block; and

24	WHEREAS, San Pablo Avenue is a state highway subject to the jurisdiction
25	of the California Department of Transportation; and
26	WHIEDEAC the California Department of Tournated in a constant that the
27	WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation requested that the
28	City of Albany adopt regulations allowing bicyclists to continue on the sidewalk on
29 30	the west side of San Pablo Avenue to the intersection of San Pablo Avenue and Marin
00	Avenue; and

1	WHEREAS, the City of Albany Traffic and Safety Commission held a public
2	meeting on January 26, 2017, considered all public comments receive, and approved a
3	motion recommending that the City Council approve an ordinance allowing bicyclists
4	to ride on the sidewalk at this location; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, the City of Albany Traffic and Safety Commission in the course
7	of their review, the Traffic and Safety Commission also requested unrelated technical
8	corrections to Section 8-12.4; and
9	
0	WHEREAS, on April 3, 2017, the City Council held a public hearing and
1	considered all public comments received, the presentation by City staff, the staff report,
12	and all other pertinent documents regarding the proposed request;
13	
14	NOW, THEREFORE, THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS
15	FOLLOWS:
16	
17	SECTION 1: CHAPTER 8 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE,
18	SECTION 8-12.4.b TITLED "RIDING ON SIDEWALKS" IS HEREBY
19	AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:
20	
21	b. Riding on Sidewalks. No person shall ride or operate a bicycle on any sidewalk in
22	the City, except that:
23	1 juveniles under the age of sixteen (16) years, exercising due care and
24	giving the pedestrian the right-of-way, may ride and operate their bicycles
25	upon the sidewalk, except such sidewalks as are in front of sehools, stores
26	or buildings used for business purposes.
27	2 persons of any age, exercising due care and giving the pedestrian the
28	right-of-way, are allowed to ride on the west sidewalk of San Pablo
29	Avenue, from the intersection of San Pablo Avenue and Marin
30	Avenue to the northern limit of the two-way bicycle path north of
31	Monroe Avenue; and on the south sidewalk of Dartmouth Street

1	within 100 feet of the southeast corner of San Pablo Avenue and
2	Dartmouth Street. Bicycle speed limit is 10 miles per hour when
3	riding on the sidewalk.
4	
5	SECTION 2: CHAPTER 8 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE,
6	SECTION 8-12.4.d TITLED "TOWING OTHER VEHICLES" IS HEREBY
7	AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:
8	
9	Deleted in its entirety.
10	
11	SECTION 3: CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT.
12	
13	The Municipal Code changes are determined to be categorically exempt from
14	the requirements of CEQA per Section 15301, "Existing Facilities" of the CEQA
15	Guidelines, which allows safety protection measures that involves negligible expansion
16	of use.
17	
18	SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.
19	
20	If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for
21	any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the
22	remaining portions of the ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or
23	phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,
24	sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid.
25	
26	SECTION 5: PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.
27	
28	This ordinance shall be posted at three public places within the City of Albany
29	and shall become effective thirty days after the date of its posting.
