A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITIZEN'S OPTIONS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (COPS) FUNDING TO PURCHASE ONE (1) TRUNARC HANDHELD NARCOTICS IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM AND SUPPLIES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000

WHEREAS, the State COPS grant program provides money to local police agencies for the purpose of enhancing public safety by supporting front line law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, funds have been awarded to the City of Albany with no matching fund requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Police Department has identified a need to deploy a handheld electronic narcotic testing device; and

WHEREAS, police department staff has received a bid to provide equipment necessary to accomplish this; and


WHEREAS, the TruNarc Handheld Narcotic Analyzer has been identified as the instrument of choice; and

WHEREAS, there are no other vendors for this one of a kind item, available for sale only through the manufacturer, Thermo Fisher Scientific; and

WHEREAS, police department staff recommends purchase of such a system using COPS grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby approves the sole source appropriation of a TruNarc Handheld Narcotic Analyzer and related services and supplies, utilizing COPS grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00.
