Background

The City of Albany Sustainability Committee is developing policies and programs to improve the energy efficiency of residential units in Albany. This survey requests information about your home energy use and your plans for energy-related upgrades. Please note that many of your home's characteristics can be found on Zillow.com.

Please note that this survey is for residential property owners only. If you are renting your home or apartment, please forward this survey to your landlord so we can include your property in our survey.

Survey participants will be eligible for a free home energy assessment by a certified Home Energy Score Assessor. The City will choose 20 residential properties for assessments based on home characteristics. Assessment data will be made available to the City to help develop effective programs that are relevant to Albany properties.
