UPDATED CITY COUNCIL ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES**

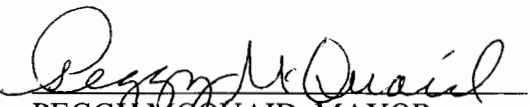
WHEREAS, the Albany City Council recognizes the need for organizational policies and procedures; and

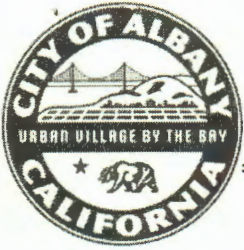
WHEREAS, proposed updates to the City Council Administrative Policies are intended to incorporate current or best practices, and compatibility with other policies, protocols, or laws; and
