In accordance with the City Charter, the term for all Appointees to Advisory Bodies is 2-years in length, with the term ending in December of even-numbered years, which coincides with the certification of the results of the General Municipal Election. Appointees may continue to serve for an interim period of up to 45 days after certification of the election until reappointed or replaced, whichever is sooner. In compliance with the requirements of the Maddy Act, Government Code Section 54970, the following appointment list is posted on an annual basis by December 31st.

Each Council Member appoints one member, and in some cases the Council as a whole appoints an "At-Large" Member. Appointments to the Planning & Zoning Commission shall be ratified by the Council as a whole. The Albany Unified School District Board of Education is also responsible for a number of appointments to City Advisory Bodies to the City Council.
