

Albany Public Art Sculpture Loan Program Search 2018

Submissions due by May 1, 2018

A residential community beautifully located on the eastern shoreline of the San Francisco bay, directly east of the Golden Gate Bridge, Albany is a small city which combines a small-town ambience with its central location in a major metropolitan region. Albany's 1.7 square miles offer a fascinating diversity with Community events, the arts, and a vibrant commercial district. The recent improvements to the Ohlone Greenway, Albany's linear park, offer an opportunity to display new sculptures in a variety of mediums.

Artists whose work are selected receive a \$1,000 stipend to help defray costs and City will provide a plaque giving recognition to the artist. Both the artist and their works will be promoted on the city's website. Selected art will be on loan for two years, and at the artist's discretion, may be made available for sale at the expiration of that period.
