SUBJECT: Discussion on Community Outreach and Engagement Opportunities

BACKGROUND

The Sustainability Committee is tasked with providing leadership, technical assistance, and education and outreach to members of the public, schools, local businesses, and city agencies on innovative programs to promote environmental sustainability through energy conservation, solid waste reduction and recycling, water conservation, pollution prevention, transportation efficiency, and other means.

In November 2016, the Committee determined the following priorities for outreach:

- Overall Goals:
 - Inspire residents of Albany to reduce their carbon footprint
 - Foster community resilience by building greater community connectivity and trust
- Suggested Actions:
 - Promote community awareness of options for living a more sustainable lifestyle through providing information about:
 - Incentives for energy upgrades
 - Electric vehicles
 - Connect community members to their neighbors/peers who have adopted sustainable practices:
 - Electric vehicle owners
 - Solar homeowners
 - Energy upgrade homeowners
 - Get community buy-in by focusing on co-benefits of personal and communitywide climate action:
 - Better health outcomes
 - Cleaner air
 - Safer sidewalks
 - Greater community resilience

DISCUSSION

In order to meet these outreach priorities, the Committee should develop a successful outreach strategy to implement in 2018. Staff recommends that the Committee prioritize sustainability topics, determine formats in which to present information, identify channels of distribution, and establish potential partnerships.

The table below highlights a list of options to help the Committee develop an outreach strategy. Staff recommends prioritizing 1-2 items from each category. Note that this is not a comprehensive list; it is simply intended to start a conversation.
