**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING  
GRANT OF FUNDS FROM THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY  
MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE PURCHASE AND  
INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Albany's Climate Action Plan, adopted in 2010, establishes a goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 25% by the year 2020, and the General Plan includes additional reduction goals of 60% by 2035 and net zero emissions by 2050; and

**WHEREAS**, through the Climate Action Plan, the City of Albany has adopted a policy to incentivize electric and plug-in hybrid vehicles through development of automobile charging infrastructure and preferential street parking spaces; and

**WHEREAS**, according to Department of Motor Vehicles statistics on registered electric vehicles in the Bay Area, the City of Albany experienced a 34% increase in electric vehicle ownership from 2015 to 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, offering publicly-owned charging stations will provide charging opportunities for residents and visitors with electric vehicles; and


**WHEREAS**, the Air District grant will cover up to \$12,000 of the purchase, install, and operations cost of electric vehicle charging stations; and

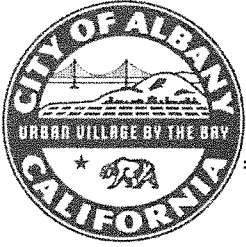
**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany will provide matching funds for City-owned charging stations; and
