

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-46**

2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL CERTIFYING**
3 **THAT THE FY2017/18 – FY2021/22 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN,**
4 **INCLUDING THE ANNUAL STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT HAS**
5 **BEEN ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF ALBANY AND IDENTIFYING THE**
6 **RMRA AS A FUNDING SOURCE FOR THE ANNUAL STREET**
7 **REHABILITATION PROJECT**

8 **WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017
9 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the
10 Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation
11 funding shortfalls statewide; and

12 **WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will
13 ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our
14 community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding
16 from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1,
17 including a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for
18 the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the City anticipates receiving an estimated \$320,000 in RMRA
20 funding in Fiscal Year 18/19 from SB 1; and

21 **WHEREAS**, this is the second year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding
22 and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation
23 projects, safety improvements, and increasing access and mobility options for the
24 traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the City uses a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1
2 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high priority and cost effective
3 projects that also meet the community’s priorities for transportation investment; and
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5 **WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will the City maintain and rehabilitate two
6 streets and add active transportation infrastructure in the City this year and several more
7 similar projects into the future; and
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9 **WHEREAS**, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs
10 Assessment found that the City’s streets and roads are in fair/good condition and this
11 revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of its road system and over the next
12 decade will bring the City’s streets and roads into very good condition; and
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14 **WHEREAS**, the City has selected to rehabilitate segments of Jackson Street and
15 Madison Street as part of its Annual Street Rehabilitation Project using the RMRA
16 funding; and

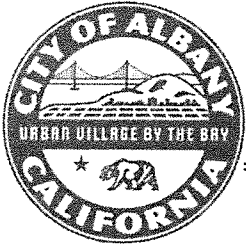
18 **WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and
19 roads infrastructure with a focus on basic road maintenance and safety will have
20 significant positive co-benefits statewide.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby
23 adopt this resolution certifying that

- 24 1. The FY2017/18 – F2021/22 Capital Improvement Plan including the 2018
25 Annual Street Rehabilitation Project has been adopted by the City of Albany
26 Identifying the RMRA as a funding source for the 2018 Annual Street
27 Rehabilitation Project including portions of Jackson and Madison Streets in the
28 expected amount of \$320,000, and
- 29 2. The estimated useful life of this rehabilitation work is approximately 10 years.

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council authorize staff to
2 submit to the CTC the required documents and project list to qualify for funding.
