# A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING A VOLUNTARY CAMPAIGN FINANCE LIMIT FOR CITY ELECTIVE OFFICES

WHEREAS, there is an interest in encouraging qualified candidates to participate in local government and seek City elective offices; and

WHEREAS, concerns over the amount of funds necessary to be raised and spent for a successful election may deter potential candidates; and

WHEREAS, the 2017-2019 City Council Strategic Plan includes the strategy of establishing a voluntary campaign finance limit for city elections with the interest in working towards achieving the goal to facilitate government accountability; and

WHEREAS, voluntary campaign finance limits can enhance the possibility for a broad array of candidates; and

WHEREAS, by establishing a voluntary campaign finance limit the City Council wishes to encourage candidates to run for City elective offices and discourage excessive campaign contributions and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, each candidate seeking elective office for either the office of City Council or City Treasurer shall have the choice of accepting or rejecting the voluntary campaign finance limits and submit such statement as part of the nomination paperwork when filing for candidacy.
