**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING AN  
AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES ON EMPLOYMENT MATTERS WITH  
THE LAW FIRM OF LIEBERT CASSIDY WHITMORE**

**WHEREAS**, the law firm of Liebert Cassidy Whitmore ("LCW") specializes in providing employment law advice to local public agencies in California; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has utilized the services of LCW to provide advice and representation on an as-needed basis over the years, most recently to assist with CALPERS compliance issues as well as confidential personnel matters; and

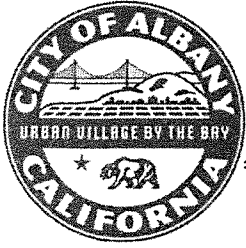
**WHEREAS**, the most recent agreement between the City and LCW was entered into in 2016, with a two-year term and a not-to-exceed amount of \$20,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has incurred approximately \$7,500 in legal expenses over the contract maximum and has pending matters which will result in additional expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, a new agreement with LCW is required in order to fund expenses to date and provide additional authorization for pending and future employment law assistance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the execution of a agreement with LCW for a two-year term not to exceed \$30,000, with authorization for the City Manager to approve an additional amount of \$20,000, and a one-year extension if determined necessary.
