A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE OPEN SPACE, RECREATIONAL PLAYFIELD AND CREEK RESTORATION ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1996-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/19

The City Council (the "Council") of the City of Albany (the "City") does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Council previously completed its proceedings in accordance with and pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500) (the "Act") to establish the City's Open Space, Recreational Playfield, and Creek Restoration Assessment District No. 1996-1 (the "Assessment District"); and

WHEREAS, the City has retained NBS for the purpose of assisting with the annual levy of the Assessment District, and the preparation and filing of an Annual Report.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **Annual Report:** The Council hereby orders NBS to prepare and file with the Clerk the Annual Report concerning the levy and collection of assessments within the Assessment District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019.
- 2. New Improvements or Changes to Existing Improvements: There are no changes to existing improvements nor are there any items being added to the list of improvements previously approved at the formation of the Assessment District.
