SECTION 3.01. OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES. All officers and department heads, except as otherwise provided, shall be appointed by the City Council and shall hold office at the pleasure of the City Council. The City Treasurer shall be elected from the City at large, and shall hold office for four (4) years and until a successor is elected and qualified. Effective at the November 2010 election the City Attorney shall be elected from the City at large for a term ending on December 5, 2011. Commencing December 6, 2011, or sooner if there is a vacancy in the office, the City Attorney shall be appointed by the City Council as provided herein. Effective December 1, 2020, or sooner if there is a vacancy in the office, the City Treasurer shall be appointed by the City Council as provided herein. The Council shall establish by ordinance the administrative offices of the City and shall designate the department heads of the City. The City Council shall be empowered to create, abolish, or reorganize departments and divisions as necessary for the proper administration of the City business, but not inconsistent with other sections of this Charter.
