WHEREAS, Pat was hired as a Maintenance Worker in 1986 and has been a dedicated City employee ever since; and


WHEREAS, Pat was the steward of the City's parks and took pride in keeping the parks in tip top shape. He developed personal relationships with many of the public using the parks; and
