the entire fee, as set by the County of Alameda. The 'City Clerk will not accept any Candidate Statement unless the fee is paid.

- 5. The Candidate should turn in to the City Clerk his/her Candidate Statement at the time he/she files his/her nomination papers.
  - 6. The City will not mail other campaign materials with the voter's pamphlet.
- 7. In the event that there are ballot measures the voter's pamphlet will contain an analysis of each measure prepared by the City Attorney. The analysis shall not exceed 500 words in length. The analysis shall be filed by the City Clerk no later than August 10, 2018 with the Alameda County Registrar of Voters.
- 8. In the event that there are ballot measures, the voter's pamphlet will contain arguments pro and con on the various measures. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments submitted shall be filed by 12:00 p.m., August 17, 2018 in the City Clerk's Office, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, California.
- 9. In the event that ballot arguments are presented, rebuttal arguments will be allowed for valid measures. These rebuttal arguments will be limited to 250 words. Arguments submitted in rebuttal of a ballot argument shall be filed by 12:00 p.m., August 24, 2018 in the City Clerk's Office, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, California.
- 10. On August 16, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. in the City Clerk's Office a drawing will be held to determine the position of various candidate names on the ballot.
- 11. The central counting place for the November 6, 2018 election will be at the County Building, 1225 Fallon Street, Oakland, in accordance with the Elections Code.

The City Clerk's Office will not charge a fee for processing a Candidate's


