Request for Blue Curb (Disabled Parking) at 1119 Key Route Boulevard** – The City has received a request to convert one (1) street parking space in front of 1119 Key Route Boulevard into a blue curb disabled parking space. The resident requesting the change has been issued a disabled person parking placard by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Recommended Action: Approve the conversion of one street parking space in front of 1119 Key Route Boulevard into a blue curb disabled parking space.
