## IN RECOGNITION OF HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH SEPTEMBER 15 – OCTOBER 15, 2018

- **WHEREAS**, Albany is home to people whose ancestry represents many nations, each adding their own distinct and dynamic perspective to our city's story; and
- **WHEREAS**, September 15th is the anniversary of the independence of five Latin American countries; Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua; and
- **WHEREAS**, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence days on September 16th and September 18th, respectively; and
- **WHEREAS**, Hispanic Americans have contributed to our prosperity and culture throughout the history of our City, the State of California, and our country; and
- **WHEREAS**, Hispanic Americans are the artists enriching our city, the entrepreneurs building our economy, scientists and engineers, educators and social leaders, and the brave men and women serving in our military; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is appropriate to increase Hispanic cultural awareness and diversity by paying tribute to the valuable contributions made by Hispanic Americans to our business, cultural, and educational communities; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Albany declared itself a Sanctuary City recognizing the dignity and civil rights of all community members including the right of all community members to live, work, and study in a City that does not subject them to prejudicial treatment or discrimination; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Albany City Council reaffirmed that we welcome and value all of our diverse community members regardless of where they are from.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Albany City Council does hereby proclaim that September 15 through October 15, 2018 to be Hispanic Heritage Month in the City of Albany, celebrating Hispanic culture, traditions, and achievements.
