# 5-1. Presentation from Home Energy Score Assessor North Lennox Regarding Energy Assessment Programs

Home Energy Assessor North Lennox discussed the latest improvements in home energy efficiency, the potential for reducing greenhouse gas emissions in the residential sector, and the potential to incorporate energy efficiency scorecards in Albany. North noted that gas water heating is an opportunity for fuel switching, and solar adoption could be accelerated.

### 6-1. Climate Mitigation & Adaptation Plan Update

Elizabeth Carrade provided an update - the SurveyMonkey survey has over 200 responses, and internal staff interviews will be conducted in the next few weeks. The CAP 2.0 subcommittee will meet to complete an emissions sources brainstorming activity created by Cascadia, and will report back at the next Sustainability Committee meeting.

### 6-2. Discussion of Subcommittee Goals & Actions

The CAP 2.0 subcommittee will focus on reducing community-wide emissions through promoting adoption of EV vehicles and technology, as well as alternatives to driving, and home electrification. The Outreach subcommittee will work to mobilize the community and conduct general awareness campaigns.

### 6-3. East Bay Community Energy Update

East Bay Community Energy presented to City Council on 10/15/2018, during which there were concerns about the recent CPUC decision to increase the Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (PCIA). EBCE will begin to provide service to residential customers in November, at the same rates as PG&E.
