SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 2019-02, Updating the Name of the Park and Recreation

Commission to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Commission and Updating the Charge of the Commission to Include Open Space within the

City of Albany

SUMMARY

The City Council conducted a review of the Advisory Bodies to the City Council on December 3, 2018 and directed staff to make changes to certain advisory bodies. The changes directed by the Council regarding the name and charge of the City's Park and Recreation Commission to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Commission are detailed within this report and the accompanying Ordinance.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Council introduce for first reading Ordinance No. 2019-02, updating the name of the Park and Recreation Commission to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Commission and updating the charge of the Commission to include open space.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In 2010, the Council conducted a comprehensive review of the City's Advisory Bodies, and adopted Resolution No. 2010-63, which changed the composition and other elements of the various advisory bodies. Since 2010, a review of the City's Advisory Bodies has occurred every two years. In June 2015 the Council conducted further review of the Social & Economic Justice Commission and decided to allow the Commission to continue until the next regular review of Advisory Bodies. The Council also conducted a review of the Advisory Bodies to the City Council in January 2016, without making any changes. Additionally, the Council updated the charge of the Community Media Access Committee in November 2017. The Council again conducted a review of the Advisory Bodies on December 3, 2018, directing certain updates to Advisory Bodies including:

- Updating the charge of the Arts Committee
- Updating the meeting procedures for the Charter Review Committee
- Ongoing training for advisory bodies members

- Transitioning the Sustainability Committee to the Climate Action Committee
- Updating the Traffic & Safety Commission to the Transportation Commission
- Including "natural areas" such as creeks and the waterfront park under the purview of the Parks & Recreation Commission

The Council has adopted Resolution No. 2018-137, that updates the charge of the Arts Committee, calls for the Charter Review Committee to meet upon request of the City Council in advance of an election, and directs training to be provided to advisory body members. In addition, the Council has adopted Resolution No. 2018-138 to update the Sustainability Committee to the Climate Action Committee.

The proposed Ordinance No.2019-02 (Attachment 1) updates the name of the Park and Recreation Commission to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Commission, and expands the charge of the Commission to provide recommendations to the City Council on matters related to open space within the City of Albany, including creeks, Albany Hill and Albany Waterfront.

The Commission reviewed the draft ordinance amendment which includes the proposed changes to the Commission's charge and name change at their January 10th meeting. Commissioners favored the name "Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Commission" rather than "Park, Recreation and Natural Areas Commission" and were very supportive of the changes to the charge of the Commission. The Commission also requested additional training and background information on the Waterfront and Creek projects that may come before them in the future.

As part of the direction from Council, the Traffic & Safety Commission will be updated to the Transportation Commission. An ordinance will be prepared in coordination with the Commission and presented to Council at an upcoming meeting to affirm these remaining changes.

2-12.1 Established.

A Parks and Recreation Department is hereby created which shall be under the direction of the Director of Parks and Recreation, subject to the general administrative direction of the City Council and advice of the Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission. (Ord. #73-010, §1; 1958 Code §2.93)

2-12.2 Organization; Duties of Director.

The Parks and Recreation Department shall consist of the Director of Parks and Recreation and such other employees as the City Council may assign to such Department. The Director of Parks and Recreation, subject to the approval of the City Council, shall organize and maintain such divisions in such Department as the operations may in his judgment require. (Ord. #73-010, §1; 1958 Code §2.94)

2-12.3 Additional Duties of Director; Appointment and Term of Office.

The Director of Parks and Recreation shall be responsible for the supervision and control of all divisions of such department and for the performance of the functions herein assigned to such department. He <u>The Director</u> shall be appointed and serve at the pleasure of the City Council. (Ord. #73-010, §1; 1958 Code §2.95)

2-12.4 Functions.

The functions of the Parks and Recreation Department are the development, maintenance and operation of the Public Parks and Recreation Service; the development and supervision of Parks and recreation areas, facilities, equipment and buildings; the maintenance, supervision, landscaping, planting and beautification of parks, park areas, play areas, public squares and areas surrounding public buildings; the planting, maintenance and removal of trees, shrubs, lawns and other growth in parking areas in public streets, parks and other public areas; and rendering of staff work for the providing of professional and technical advice to the City Council and the Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission and the performance of such other functions as may be assigned by the City Council or prescribed by ordinance of the City. (Ord. #73-010, \$1; 1958 Code \$2.96)

2-17 PARKS, AND RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE COMMISSION.

2-17.1 Established; Composition; Appointment; Term.

There is hereby established within the City a commission to be known as the "Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City". The Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City shall consist of seven (7) members, as follows:

a. Five (5) members of such Commission shall be appointed by Councilmembers; each Councilmember shall appoint one (1) member to the Commission.

b. Two (2) members of such Commission shall be nominated by the President of the Board of Education, subject, however, to approval of such nomination by a majority of the Board of Education as a whole.

The terms of the two (2) members shall be for a two (2) year period. and shall be staggered. To this end, the terms of the first appointments shall be: One (1) for one (1) year, and one (1) for two (2) years. Each member shall serve until their his successor has been appointed and qualified in accordance with Albany City Charter.

Such members shall be electors of the City at the time of confirmation of the appointment, and no member of the Board of Education shall be eligible to serve on this Commission.

2-17.2 Compensation.

Such Commissioners shall serve without compensation. (Ord. #58-042, §2; Ord. #75-04, §2; 1958 Code §2.41; Ord. #97-02)

2-17.3 Organization; Election and Term of Chair and Vice Chair Chairman, Secretary, Etc..

The Park and Recreation Commission shall organize by electing from its members one (1) Chair, and one (1) Secretary Vice Chair and such other officers as may be deemed necessary by the Commission. The Chair, Secretary and Vice Chair such other officers shall hold office for a period of one (1) year. (Ord. #58-042, §3; 1958 Code §2.42)

2-17.4 Powers and Duties.

It shall be the duty of the Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City to advise the Superintendent of Recreation and the City Council regarding all matters of public recreation and all matters pertaining to parks, open space including creeks, Albany Waterfront Park, and Albany Hill, street trees, parking strips, parkways, squares and similar area within the City. Such Commission shall endeavor to formulate a parks, recreation and open space master recreation plan, select and propose to the Council sites for playgrounds, make recommendations for acquisition and maintenance of playgrounds for children and recreation centers for the public, and generally advise both—the City Council and the Superintendent of Recreation in matters connected with parks,—and recreation and open space in general. It shall be a function of the Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City to promote and encourage among various public and private agencies and individuals the development of such recreational facilities and programs as shall benefit all citizens of the City. (Ord. #58-042, §4; 1958 Code §2.43)

2-17.5 Regular and Special Meetings; Notice of Special Meeting.

The Parks, and Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City shall hold one (1) regular meeting each month, at such date or time as the Commission shall designate; special
