A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO CONTRACT NO. C19-1 2018 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE AND ATP STRIPING & SIGNAGE PROJECT WITH VSS INTERNATIONAL FOR CIP 21000

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-36 to adopt the FY17/18 – FY21-22 Capital Improvement Project budget including Project No. 21000 Annual Street Rehabilitation Project and No. 23000 Annual Active Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City awarded Contract No. C19-1 to VSS International on January 22, 2019 for construction of the 2018 Pavement Maintenance and ATP Striping & Signage Project; and

WHEREAS, staff identified additional pavement needs that required immediate attention; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Safety Commission approved traffic calming measures for Peralta Avenue, Francis Street, and Taylor Street; and

WHEREAS, Council directed staff to proceed with design and construction of the Washington Avenue Traffic Calming Project on February 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Council has appropriated funds for both street maintenance and ATP striping and signage for FY2018/19;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to approve Contract Change Order No. 1 to Contract No. C19-1 with VSS International to construct the Washington Ave Traffic Calming Project

and traffic calming measures on Peralta, Francis and Taylor in the amount \$115,243.54 from previously appropriated funds for CIP Projects No. 24009 (\$59,743.16) and CIP Project No. 25001 (\$55,500.38).
