WHEREAS, breastfeeding is economical, providing its benefits at little or no cost; and

WHEREAS, mothers need the support of fathers, friends, health professionals, and communities to initiate and sustain breastfeeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, in appreciation of breastfeeding mothers and of all the dedicated volunteers, professionals, communities, and organizations who support their efforts, the Albany City Council does hereby proclaim August 1-7, 2019 as World Breastfeeding Week.
