A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH PARISI TRANSPORTATION CONSULTING FOR ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2018, the City Council authorized staff to execute Contract #C18-53 between the City of Albany and Parisi Transportation Consulting for the Kains/Adams Bicycle Boulevard pilot and additional professional services; and

WHEREAS, Parisi Transportation Consulting has completed designs for the Kains/Adams Bicycle Boulevard pilot and helped staff prepare a successful grant application for Ohlone Greenway Trail Safety Improvement Projects at the Masonic Ave/Marin Ave and Masonic Ave/Solano Ave intersections; and

WHEREAS, Parisi Transportation Consulting has supported staff on several transportation planning, design, and traffic engineering projects as needed; and

WHEREAS, staff has a continued need for transportation planning, design, and traffic engineering services to develop various street safety and active transportation capital improvement projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute Amendment 1 to Contract C18-53 between the City of Albany and Parisi Transportation Consulting for the Kains/Adams Bicycle Boulevard pilot and additional professional services, extending the contract through June 30, 2021 and increasing the 'not to exceed' amount from \$75,000 to \$175,000, with the increase over the original contract to be allocated over two fiscal years 2019-20 & 2020-21.
