WHEREAS, the Study provides a design palette to guide roadway design, sidewalks and public spaces; and sense of place design elements for Solano Avenue; and


1 **WHEREAS**, in February – May 2019, the Planning & Zoning Commission, Traffic

4 staff and the consultant; and

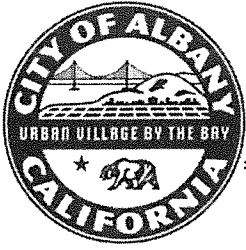

14 coordinating with the City of Berkeley on long-range planning of the Solano Avenue
15 corridor for all travel modes; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council direct the Traffic &
18 Safety Commission and staff to evaluate and report back regarding bicycle safety
19 improvements for Solano Avenue as part of an update to the Active Transportation Plan
20 and any further development of the concepts in this Study.
