 - **4-1. Study Session on the City of Albany Sidewalk Program.** On June 20, 2016, the City Council adopted a Sidewalk Repair Policy through Resolution 2016-29. In November 2016, Albany voters passed Ballot Measure P1 which provides a funding stream for sidewalk repairs through a 10-year parcel tax.

The Policy requires that the Traffic and Safety Commission review the sidewalk repair criteria and propose prioritization of projects annually. Staff will present a proposal for prioritization criteria for the Sidewalk Program. The Sidewalk Policy and the voter approved ordinance (2016-03) are provided as attachments.
