Elizabeth Carrade provided an update – The platform upgrades are complete, but signups are still low. Committee Member Peterson will be promoting the platform at two upcoming City events: Senior Center Resource Expo & Earth Day Beach Cleanup.

4-3. East Bay Community Energy (EBCE) Update

Griffing provided an update – Albany's opt out rate is low compared to other cities in Alameda County, and the Renewable 100 opt up rate is now the highest after City of Piedmont. EBCE will be reaching out to large commercial customers to encourage them to opt back in and/or opt up.

There will be a community meeting focused on reach codes on Wednesday, April 24 at 1947 Center St. in Berkeley.

EBCE is trying to get ahold of natural gas data, and is reaching out to large commercial customers to get ok to provide aggregated data to EBCE cities.
