The Board received troubling reports on recycling redemption center closures in Northern California and on legislative activity on recycling during the recently completed legislative session. There seems to be a lack of political will to address the very serious recycling challenges that we face with regard to both redemption of bottles subject to the deposit requirement, and our increasing stream of plastic waste. In the next session of the Legislature, recycling advocates will need to be well organized and come together in support of agreed-upon priorities if we are to save our surviving redemption centers and pass legislation that will significantly affect plastic waste.

In the tables reporting the various jurisdictions' expenditures (pages 4 & 5), the City of Albany's expenditures are footnoted as follows: "The City of Albany has submitted its audited financial and compliance reports; however, they are not compliant with reporting requirements. The figures included in this table for Albany are considered estimates."
