**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany desires to join together with the members of the CSAC Excess Insurance Authority (Authority) for the purpose of jointly funding and/or establishing excess and other insurance programs as determined; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that it is necessary for each member of the Authority to delegate to a person[s] or position[s] authority to act on the member's behalf in matters relating to the member and the Authority.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City Council of the City of Albany does hereby approve becoming a member of the CSAC Excess Insurance Authority, authorizes the City Manager to execute the CSAC Excess Insurance Authority Joint Powers Agreement, and except as to actions that must be approved by the City Council, the City Manager is hereby appointed to act in all matters relating to the member and the Authority.
