## A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF A JOINT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA RESILIENCE CHALLENGE

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and Climate Action & Adaptation Plan both emphasize need to address climate change impacts, and draw special attention to the threat of sea level rise and flooding to our bayfront community; and

WHEREAS, the California Resilience Challenge is offering over \$2 million to California communities to improve local resilience to climate change, including drought, flooding and sea level rise, extreme heat, and wildfire; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a regional approach, as climate change impacts like flooding and sea level rise do not stop at city borders.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Albany City Council hereby support the submittal of a joint grant application with the cities of Berkeley and Emeryville to the California Resilience Challenge for a sea level rise and groundwater vulnerability analysis; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Albany City Council authorize the City Manager to sign two letters of support: one for the City joint grant application and one for the complementary San Francisco Estuary Institute grant application.
