

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, including a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving an estimated \$310,000 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 20/21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process through the City's Transportation Commission and City Council to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City uses a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate 3,300 feet of Marin Avenue and improve active transportation infrastructure in the City this year and several more similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs
Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in good/at risk condition and this
revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of its road system and over the next
decade will bring the City's streets and roads into very good condition; and


WHEREAS, the City has selected to rehabilitate a segment of Marin Avenue between Masonic Avenue and Tulare Avenue as part of its Annual Street Rehabilitation Program using the RMRA funding; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic road maintenance and safety will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby adopt this resolution certifying that
