2	A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING RULES
3	FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020, ELECTION
4	
5	WHEREAS, the General Municipal Election will be consolidated with the
6	Statewide Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the City Council desires to instruct the City staff on certain rules
9	which should be followed during that election; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, these rules will assist the staff in the impartial handling of all
12	candidates;
13	
14	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY
15	DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS
16	FOLLOWS:
17	
18	THAT, the City Clerk shall use the following rules during the election of
19	November 3, 2020:
20	
21	1. Candidates may file a Statement of Qualifications.
22	
23	2. Candidate Statements will be limited to 200 words.
24	
25	3. The City Clerk will not correct spelling and/or grammatical errors occurring
26	in the Candidates Statement.
27	
28	4. A printing fee will be paid by the Candidate at the time of filing the
29	nomination papers if they choose to file a Candidate Statement. The Candidate will pay the

entire fee, as set by the County of Alameda. The City Clerk will not accept any Candidate Statement unless the fee is paid.

- 5. The Candidate should turn in to the City Clerk his/her Candidate Statement at the time he/she files his/her nomination papers.
  - 6. The City will not mail other campaign materials with the voter's pamphlet.
- 7. In the event that there are ballot measures the voter's pamphlet will contain an analysis of each measure prepared by the City Attorney. The analysis shall not exceed 500 words in length. The analysis shall be filed by the City Clerk no later than August 7, 2020 with the Alameda County Registrar of Voters.
- 8. In the event that there are ballot measures, the voter's pamphlet will contain arguments pro and con on the various measures. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments submitted shall be filed by 12:00 p.m., August 14, 2020 in the City Clerk's Office, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, California.
- 9. In the event that ballot arguments are presented, rebuttal arguments will be allowed for valid measures. These rebuttal arguments will be limited to 250 words. Arguments submitted in rebuttal of a ballot argument shall be filed by 12:00 p.m., August 21, 2020 in the City Clerk's Office, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, California.
- 10. On August 13, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. in the City Clerk's Office a drawing will be held to determine the position of various candidate names on the ballot.
- 11. The central counting place for the November 3, 2020 election will be at the County Building, 1225 Fallon Street, Oakland, in accordance with the Elections Code.
