2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A FEE**
3 **WAIVER FOR OUTDOOR DINING ENCROACHMENT PERMITS DURING**
4 **THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SHELTER IN PLACE ORDER**

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6 **WHEREAS**, the City of Albany has an encroachment permit process to allow for outdoor
7 dining on public right of way; and

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9 **WHEREAS**, the Economic Development Committee discussed the issue of outdoor dining
10 on June 4, 2020 and forwarded a recommendation to the City Council to implement fee waivers
11 during the restricted operating period; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Transportation Commission discussed the issue of outdoor dining on June
13 25, 2020 and approved a motion recommending the following to the City Council:

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- 15 1. Authorize encroachment permit fees be waived
 - 16 2. Authorize staff to approve permits for the duration of the county health restriction
 - 17 3. Give staff flexibility on the number of spaces per parklet
 - 18 4. Give staff flexibility on requirement to move equipment when not in use
 - 19 5. Post reduced speed advisory signs
 - 20 6. Monitor 85% speeds for possible regulatory speed signs when parklets are in place; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Alameda County Public Health Officer issued a revised order on June 18,
22 2020 that allows for outdoor dining in the County effective June 19, 2020.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby waives
25 encroachment permit application fees during the restricted operating period.
