Staff recommendation: that the Council adopt Resolution No. 2020-83, calling and giving Notice of a General Election to be held November 3, 2020 and requesting the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County to consolidate said election with the Statewide General Election; authorizing the City Clerk or their duly authorized officers to carry out all the necessary procedures for said election for the purpose of electing three persons to fill the Office of City Council Member and two persons to fill the Office of Board of Education Member

City Clerk Hsu presented the staff report. Every election, the City submit a resolution to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors calling the election and requesting the County to consolidate with the Statewide General Election. Electing the City Council Members and the Board of Education Members were erroneously omitted from the recently adopted resolutions that included ballot measures. This November, there are three City Council seats and two Board of Education seats up for election.

A summary of public comment is as follows: consolidate election with the County saves money and paperwork and concern that 4-year term for elected office seats is too long and doesn't allow change of leadership and rotation.


