A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE ACTC COVID-19 RAPID RESPONSE BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS GRANT

WHEREAS, in light of the current COVID-19 pandemic and the increased usage of bicycle and pedestrian networks throughout local community areas and businesses, the Alameda County Transportation Commission (ACTC) has implemented the COVID-19 Rapid Response Bicycle and Pedestrian Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, this program is a non-competitive funding opportunity that would award the City a \$75,000 grant to fund an eligible project, for which the local fund matching requirement has been waived; and

WHEREAS, the City has already begun implementing a Citywide sidewalk shaving program, with the intention to supplement longer-term capital improvements to the City's Priority Pedestrian Network with foundational maintenance efforts; and

WHEREAS, short-term improvements to increase immediate walkability and safe pedestrian access are the precise scope of this grant program, with sidewalk shaving confirmed as an eligible project that fits within the short timeline for completion of project construction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes staff to submit the Albany Priority Pedestrian Network Sidewalk Shaving Project to the Alameda County Transportation Commission for a FY20/21 COVID-19 Rapid Response Bicycle & Pedestrian Projects Grant, and authorizes the City Manager to execute a Funding Agreement with the Alameda County Transportation Commission upon grant award.
