A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. C21-14 FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES UNDER CIP NO. 25007 – MASONIC INTERSECTIONS (OHLONE TRAIL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS)

WHEREAS, the City of Albany adopted Resolution No. 2012-25, adopting the Albany Active Transportation Plan (ATP) following a two-year community planning process; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Albany Active Transportation Plan (ATP) identifies the Ohlone Greenway Crossing Enhancements and the Masonic Avenue Bicycle Route as high priority projects; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission (previously known as Traffic & Safety Commission) recommended prioritization of improvements at the intersections of Masonic/Marin Avenues and Masonic/Solano Avenues in the Albany Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) to address safety issues for bicycles and pedestrians crossing these intersections on the Ohlone Greenway; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-36 authorizing the adoption of the FY2018-2022 Five Year Capital Improvement Plan which established CIP No. 25007 - Masonic Intersection Improvements to prioritize safety improvements at the Masonic/Marin Avenue and Masonic/Solano Avenues intersections; and


WHEREAS, The California Transportation Commission awarded the project a grant in the amount of \$410,000 through its Active Transportation Program in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City has utilized Oberkamper & Associates Civil Engineers, Inc. for engineering design services and is pleased with the quality of services and overall value of the work performed, including preliminary evaluation work for the Masonic Intersections (Ohlone Trail Safety Improvements) project; and

WHEREAS, Oberkamper & Associates Civil Engineers, Inc. has provided a proposal for engineering design services for CIP No. 25007 – Masonic Intersections (Ohlone Trail Safety Improvements), which Staff has deemed to be competitive with other firms offering this service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Contract NO. C21-14 with Oberkamper & Associates Civil Engineers, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$74,720 for a one-year contract for professional engineering design services, using previously appropriated funds for CIP No. 25007 – Masonic Intersections (Ohlone Trail Safety Improvements).
