**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY  
IN APPRECIATION OF NICK PILCH  
FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, Nick Pilch was elected to the office of City Council in November 2014 and served a two-year term as Member of the City Council following the passing of Mayor Peggy Thomsen; and

**WHEREAS**, Nick Pilch was re-elected to the office of City Council in November 2016, and served another four year term through 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, during his terms Nick Pilch has served the City as Council Member, Vice Mayor, and as Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, Nick Pilch has represented the City by serving as appointee and/or alternate on several regional bodies including the Association of Bay Area Governments General Council, the Alameda County Transportation Commission, the East Bay Community Energy Joint Powers Authority, and the Waste Management Authority; and


**WHEREAS**, Nick Pilch has also represented the City at the Alameda County Mayors Conference during his service as Mayor; and


**WHEREAS**, during Nick Pilch’s terms on the City Council, the Council has addressed a significant number of important issues and programs including but not limited to approval of a Disposition and Development Agreement to develop a City owned parcel for an affordable housing project of 62 units of 100% affordable housing, the construction and opening of Peggy Thomsen Pierce Street Park, the “Albany Loop” art installation on the Ohlone Greenway, the approval of a complete streets plan for Solano Avenue, and the launch of a Specific Plan for San Pablo Avenue; and

1           **WHEREAS**, as Mayor, Nick Pilch has actively participated in regional  
2 conversations and engaged with the Alameda County Public Health Department  
3 regarding the COVID-19 pandemic; and


4           **WHEREAS**, having served two consecutive terms, Nick Pilch was unable to run
