Berkeley Food and Housing Project Narrative Report

Jan 2020 - March 2020

Activities To-Date

The Housing Navigation team continues to support clients accessing Rapid Rehousing through Albany Project Hope. This includes three clients residing in an Oakland residence, a client in Alameda, and three clients occupying the master leased residence in Richmond. The Housing Navigators have supported all clients in applying for additional subsidized housing opportunities and have tended to the individual needs identified on each client's housing stability plan. This quarter, additional care was taken to support two clients in establishing medical insurance, medical care, cash income, and food stamps for the first time in over two years. The lead Housing Navigator also supported one of these clients in applying for ongoing case management services from the Regional Center. The application is currently in process.

As stated in the previous quarterly narrative, Albany Housing Navigation has continued to support a client in Rapid Rehousing who is navigating immigration services and receiving care for a cancer diagnosis. This quarter, the individual received a match to a low-cost apartment in subsidized senior housing. Due to COVID-19 and the shelter-in-place ordinance, the senior housing organization has paused on intakes for their building. The client's match is still valid and will continue the intake process once shelter-in-place is lifted. Additionally, the client has begun working part-time hours to supplement his income and appears to be making significant strides in his physical wellness.

Housing Navigation has also continued to support three clients accessing RRH in a master leased house in Richmond. The team has engaged in regular weekly in-person check-ins with the household and supported the clients with shared living skills. Such skills have included the creation of chore schedules, balanced use of shared spaces, and conflict resolution. The team has also supported each client's goals for income, medical care, permanent housing, and education.

Housing Navigation continues to conduct regular outreach at various locations in Albany, including the library, community center, Ohlone Greenway, Albany CARES program, and the shower program. The team has also added a shopping plaza, located on San Pablo Ave north of Buchanan St., as a regular outreach site. The team has continued to refer clients to appropriate services to expand their support network. This quarter, the team referred three clients for intake at Berkeley Mental Health and supported four clients in registering for Lifelong medical care. The team has also responded to several outreach requests made by the Albany community on behalf of homeless residents. This quarter, outreach efforts have included support with conflict resolution between homeless individuals accessing the library and community center spaces. In collaboration with community center and library staff, the outreach team engaged these individuals by offering housing assistance and encouraging behavior that would allow their continued access to community spaces.

Lastly, the Albany Project HOPE team provided emergency housing resources in response to the shelter-in-place ordinance. With support from additional Berkeley Food and Housing Project staff,

the Albany team outreached to homeless individuals in the Albany area to offer immediate motel assistance, personal protective equipment (such as gloves and masks), emergency food resources, and transportation assistance. More information regarding these efforts is outlined in the narrative successes.

This quarter included 25 total clients enrolled into Housing Navigation, with three exiting after securing permanent housing and two exiting due to no contact from the clients. There were also a total of 18 individuals enrolled into outreach, with three exiting due to no contact, one accessing permanent housing independently, and seven switched to Housing Navigation. One client was also exited from outreach after exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. The client was referred to a county motel program with on-site medical support.

Successes

Since January 2020, two clients in Albany Housing Navigation have received Shelter Plus Care vouchers for subsidized housing. The Housing Navigation team supported clients in finalizing their access to vouchers and will continue to support the clients in a housing search. As previously stated, a RRH client has also received a match to senior subsidized housing. While the shelter-in-place ordinance has impacted the housing process for these clients, the team is still supporting housing efforts and working with landlords to identify appropriate units.

In July 2019, the Albany Project HOPE team received a referral for a homeless family in Albany. Housing Navigation provided immediate motel assistance and quickly supported the family with accessing Rapid Rehousing. As of March 2020, the family has reached financial stability and has successfully exited from the Albany RRH into permanent housing. The Albany Project HOPE program has also supported two households with maintaining permanent housing through the use of Homeless Prevention funds. The team supported each household with developing a long-term plan to ensure housing stability after accessing the one-time financial assistance from Albany, as well as coordinated with property owners to ensure rent payment.

In response to COVID-19 and the shelter-in-place ordinance, the Housing Navigation team engaged in successful outreach efforts to support clients with emergency motel assistance. Twelve individuals accepted and moved into motel rooms through Albany Project HOPE. Housing Navigation provided in-person outreach several times a week during motel stays, offering resources to meet individual needs, offering education on COVID-19 and the appropriate use of protective gear, and monitoring potential symptoms. When one client exhibited symptoms of COVID-19, the team successfully supported the client in accessing an Alameda County motel resource with on-site medical staff. Additionally, the team received inquiries through the City of Berkeley's By Name's List to help locate other individuals that the county deemed eligible for a motel program called Safer Ground. The team successfully contacted previously exited clients to support them in accessing this emergency resource.

Challenges

Due to the success of the master leased house for women in Richmond, the Albany Project HOPE team has endeavored to secure an additional house for men enrolled in Housing Navigation. The lead case manager visited several housing locations with the intention to master lease. Unfortunately, the housing sites visited did not resemble the same level of quality and safety offered in the Richmond house. While the Albany team still hopes to secure another master leased house in the future, the events of COVID-19 have paused this effort.

Additionally, the current state of shelter-in-place has slowed progress with other clients who have secured subsidized housing matches. While their matches to permanent supportive housing are still valid, there is uncertainty about the timeline of helping clients move into permanent housing.










