**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW PATROL VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the State Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) grant program provides money to local police agencies for the purpose of enhancing public safety by supporting front line law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Police Department has identified a need to replace two patrol vehicles; and

WHEREAS, State Contract #1-18-23-14B, is a cooperative purchasing contract with the State of California, Department of General Services, Procurement Division, which allows for local government agencies to benefit from the state competitive bidding and vendor selection process; and

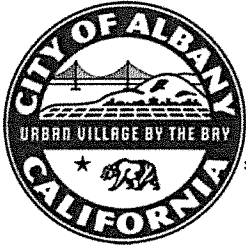
WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code Section 2-27.2 authorizes the City to use the above mentioned purchasing method; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council authorizes the use of COPS funds and Police reserve equipment funds to assist in the purchase of two (2) new patrol vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of two (2) new patrol vehicles under State Contact #1-18-23-14B and outfitting of those vehicles using a combination of Police reserve equipment funds (\$100,000.00) and COPS grant funds (\$25,000.00) at a total purchase and outfitting cost not to exceed \$125,000.00 for both vehicles.
