The Albany Police Department also affirms that the undue enforcement of immigration violations by local police erodes and damages the public trust that is so vital to maintaining public safety for all. The immigration status of individuals alone is generally not a matter for police action.

Albany Police are prohibited from contacting, detaining, or arresting someone based solely on the suspicion that an individual is undocumented. Targeting non-criminals jeopardizes our ability to protect our community. We do not enforce federal law – it's not our job.
