A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, Caltrans provides planning grants to municipal governments for various types of transportation planning initiatives. Caltrans is currently awarding approximately \$18 million in grants for the purpose of assisting local agencies in developing Local Road Safety Plans on a "first come, first serve" basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is eligible for a grant of \$40,000 and is required to contribute \$5,000 to the project; and

WHEREAS, On June 24th, 2021, the Transportation Commission discussed the opportunity and approved a motion recommending that the City Council authorize the City Manager to submit a grant application to the Caltrans Local Road Safety Plan Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a grant application and enter into a funding agreement with the California Department of Transportation.
