**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION
AND ENTER INTO FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, Caltrans provides planning grants to municipal governments for various types of transportation planning initiatives. Caltrans is currently awarding approximately \$18 million in grants for the purpose of assisting local agencies in developing Local Road Safety Plans on a “first come, first serve” basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is eligible for a grant of \$40,000 and is required to contribute \$5,000 to the project; and

WHEREAS, On June 24th, 2021, the Transportation Commission discussed the opportunity and approved a motion recommending that the City Council authorize the City Manager to submit a grant application to the Caltrans Local Road Safety Plan Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a grant application and enter into a funding agreement with the California Department of Transportation.
