A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE ONE PIERCE TYPE I FIRE ENGINE IN A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$864,458.11

WHEREAS, the Albany Fire Department uses fire engines to carry out their primary mission of protecting lives and property; and

WHEREAS, Albany Fire Department has an established replacement schedule for Fire Department apparatus based on the service life, reasonable maintenance costs, technological advancements, and safe operations; and

WHEREAS, the 1997 Pierce Saber fire engine has reached the end of its service life and is past it's scheduled replacement; and

WHEREAS, Pierce Manufacturing Co. has been competitively bid by other agencies through the HGAC contracts for co-operative purchasing and The City of Albany is currently a member with HGAC; and

WHEREAS, The purchase of this vehicle was anticipated during the fiscal year of 2019/2020 as a replacement for our 1997 Pierce engine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby Authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement to use the Houston-Galveston Area Council contracts with Pierce Manufacturing to purchase one Pierce Type I Fire Engine in a not-to-exceed amount of \$864,458.11, which includes sales tax.
