A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE COASTAL CONSERVANCY

WHEREAS, planning and implementation of the Codornices Creek between Kains Avenue to Interstate 80 has been ongoing since the late 1990's, three phases have been completed to date, a fourth phase has funds authorized for implementation; and

WHEREAS, using these grant funds the fifth planning phase for Codornices Creek can now be started to restore the creek, improve habitat, provide stormwater pollution prevention features, add trail connections, provide recreational and environmental education opportunities, provide greater access to green space for residents, and provide a green street retrofit along San Pablo Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this program is a competitive funding opportunity that has awarded the City of Albany a \$271, 357 grant with a \$10,000 local funding match requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes staff to appropriate the proceeds of the Codornices Creek Restoration Phase V Planning Project grant to the project, and authorizes the City Manager to execute a Funding Agreement upon grant award with the California State Coastal Conservancy.
