## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-87**

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED \$238,394 WITH SHI INTERNATIONAL CORP. FOR THE UPGRADE OF THE CITY'S VMWARE INFRASTRUCTURE TO A NUTANIX HYPERCONVERGE INFRASTRUCTURE AND 5-YEAR LICENSING FEES FOR \$848,388

WHEREAS, the City has an Information Technology Strategic Plan which calls for the replacement of obsolete equipment in a timely fashion to ensure continuity of critical City systems; and

WHEREAS, with the vast changes in the City's information technology (IT) support infrastructure, service management processes and procedures, the City's current VMware virtual infrastructure which includes a Storage Area Network (SAN) with an end-of-life support is no longer adequate to support the information technology goals and objectives of the City; and

WHEREAS, upgrading the virtual infrastructure to an Hyperconverge Infrastructure (HCI) design is necessary to provide additional flexibility, resilience, enhanced security, remote work efficiency and future expandability of the City's and Police Department network infrastructures to ensure business continuity; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking a firm with proven experience, knowledge and expertise to assist with the upgrade of the City's VMware virtual infrastructure to a Hyperconverged Infrastructure was released on July 8, 2021 with a response deadline of August 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS, SHI International Corp. (SHI) submitted a proposal for design, equipment, software and services required for the migration from the existing VMware environment to a hyperconverged infrastructure ("HCI"); and

WHEREAS, ClientFirst and the City's Information Technology Manager reviewed the proposal submitted by SHI with the conditions specified in the RFP and based on objective criteria including but not limited to responsiveness to the RFP, relevant experience, qualifications, the design solution's flexibility, resiliency, enhanced security, future expandability, and overall cost; and

WHEREAS, the SHI solution will enhance the City's capacity to respond to unprecedented events like the pandemic or other major disasters as the solution will enhance the City's overall work capacity for both on premise workforce and remote workforce providing increased flexibility, better data throughput, resiliency, enhanced security, remote work efficiency and future expandability of the City's network infrastructure by improving the Input/Output Operations per Second (IOPS) which is a measurement of performance for hard drives (HDDs or SSDs) and storage area networks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract not-to-exceed \$238,394 with SHI for the upgrade of the City's VMware virtual infrastructure to a Nutanix Hyperconverged Infrastructure and 5-year licensing fees not-to-exceed \$848,388.
