

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE WASHINGTON AVENUE PHASE TWO PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Albany maintains 29.4 miles of public streets and roadways, with an overall pavement condition index (PCI) of 60; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-108, which adopted the FY19/20-23/24 Capital Improvement Plan and appropriated budget for the first three fiscal years of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP 21000) is included in the Capital Improvement Plan, and reflects the City's commitment to invest in improving the Citywide PCI on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, in the City's Active Transportation Plan, Washington Avenue is designated as a Bike Boulevard, and was classified in poor condition in the City's 2019 Pavement Management Plan, and so was selected and approved for pavement rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2020, the City Council authorized the phasing of the Washington Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project into Phases I and II, due to conflicts with EBMUD planned utility work, and on July 20, 2020, the City Council awarded Contract No. C20-48 to MVC Enterprises to construct Phase I of the project; and

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2021, construction of the Washington Avenue Phase I Pavement Rehabilitation Project was substantially completed; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared the bid and contract documents necessary to bid Phase II of the Washington Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project for construction; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of the rehabilitation of the portion of Washington Avenue between Cornell Avenue and Masonic Avenue including paving restoration, storm drain pipe repair, concrete curbs and gutters, sidewalk, eight new curb ramps, valley gutters, street base repairs, subgrade preparation, hot-mix asphalt paving, pavement markings and striping for pedestrian and bicycle use; and

WHEREAS, The Project is determined to be categorically exempt under CEQA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council authorizes the City Manager to approve a Call for Bids for construction of Phase II of the Washington Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Contract No. C21-49).
